



Town of Cedar Point Board of Commissioners
Regular Meeting
June 28, 2022

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The Town of Cedar Point Board of Commissioners held their regularly scheduled monthly meeting on Tuesday, June 28, 2022 at 6:30 PM at Town Hall. Mayor Hatsell determined a quorum to be present and opened the meeting.

PRESENT: Mayor Hatsell, Commissioners Bray, Castellano, Nash, Winberry, Town Manager Rief, Town Clerk Calhoun and public.

Pastor Jeff Duncan of Grace Church presented the Invocation, followed by the Mayor leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Town's newest employees, Ken Howell and Brian Medlock, were introduced to the Board. Ken and Brian will be working with the Public Works Department.

An Annexation Petition to annex 207 Hidden Bay Drive into the Town was discussed at the June 23, 2022 Agenda Work Session. Commissioner Bray made a **Motion** to approve the subdivision request as presented. The Motion carried 5-0.

A Resolution for the financing of the gym building purchase was presented next for Board consideration. Commissioner Nash made a **Motion** to approve the Resolution for Financing of the Gym Building. The Motion carried 5-0.

Deputy Nakamura presented his report. He stated that all hands will be on deck for the July 3 fireworks display; Little Bay at Masonic and Sherwood Avenue will both be closed to through traffic.

Mr. Rief stated that the inspector will be coming Thursday to inspect gym building.
